
B.VOCABULARY CONTEST

- ➤ Success Mindset


All the topics were covered intensively by the resource speaker and the students were also actively participated and adequately benefited which simultaneously improves a good results in the upcoming examinations & in their Career.








CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM




YOUTH DAY


NATIONAL FILARIA DAY








CHRISTMAS DAY CELEBRATIONS




NATIONAL AIDS DAY






