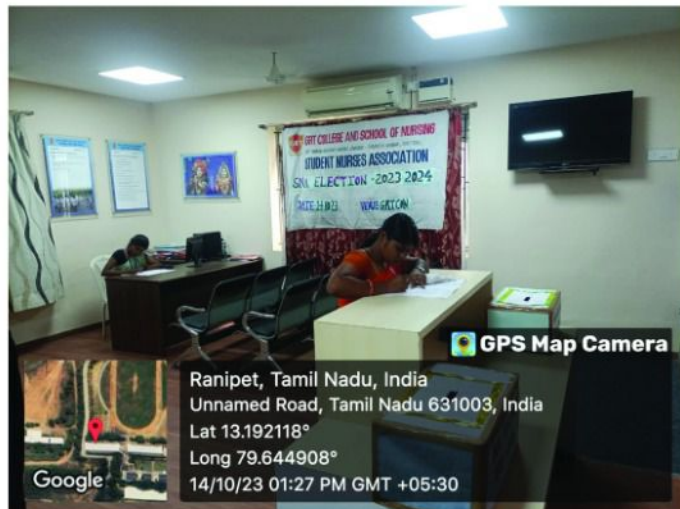

14. TNAI - 30TH SNAI BIENNIAL CONFERENCE

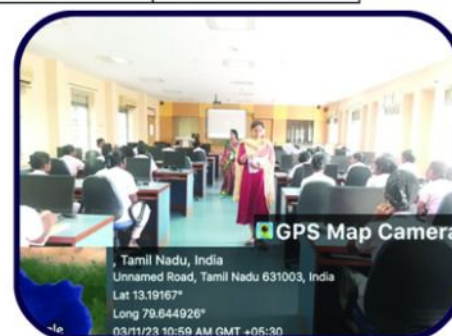
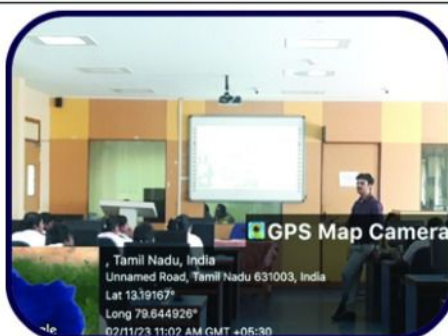
