NEWS AND EVENTS

1. RISE PROGRAM

A three-day Readiness through Intensive Simulation for Entry level nurses Training Program was conducted at Apollo Simulation Centre, Vanagaram, to enhance the clinical skills and critical thinking abilities of 88 final-year B.Sc. Nursing students as three batches from 22.09.2025 to 30.09.2025

Day 1 began with an introduction to simulation training by Mrs. Durga Devi. Students actively participated in four skill stations covering catheterization, Ryle's tube insertion, IV cannulation, and wound dressing. Afternoon sessions focused on critical thinking, decision-making, the ABCDE approach, and MEWS, followed by a quiz.

Day 2 opened with an interactive activity to strengthen teamwork and cooperation. Practical sessions included defibrillator handling, infection control, nasopharyngeal insertion, and oxygen administration. Afternoon practice covered drug calculation, splint and cervical traction, tracheostomy, and colostomy care. A quiz reinforced the concepts.

Day 3 featured a lecture on Basic Life Support (BLS) and AED usage, including CPR modifications for pregnant women. Students engaged in scenario-based practice, applying life-saving skills in cardiac arrest situations. The afternoon OSCE assessed competence across eight stations, including CPR, airway management, injections, catheterization, waste segregation, and IV insertion.

The program successfully integrated theory with hands-on training, equipping students with confidence, teamwork, and essential clinical readiness for patient care.





2. UNIVERSITY RESEARCH DAY – ARIVELVI 2025

On 26.09.2025, six B.Sc. (N) IV Year students from GRT College of Nursing participated in University Research Day – Arivelvi 2025 at Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai. The event, graced by Thiru Ma. Subramanian, Hon'ble Minister for Health, and presided over by Dr. K. Narayanasamy, highlighted recognition of the best research studies with cash awards and Best Institution Awards. The program offered enriching exposure, motivating students toward research excellence.

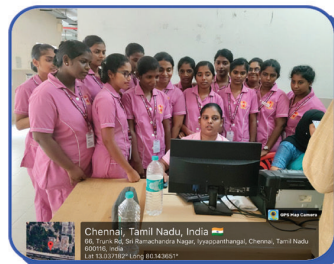
1. CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY

Later, Ms. Tamil Bharathi guided them to the Medical Records Room, explaining systematic storage and long-term maintenance of records. The visit enriched students' understanding of digital healthcare practices and efficient record management in hospital settings.

STAFF DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES

1.FOUR-DAY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY AND BASIC STATISTICS

The GRT College of Nursing, in collaboration with SCARF, organized a Four-Day Faculty Development Programme on Research Methodology and Basic Statistics in September 2025.

Day 1: Introduction to Quantitative Research (September 2nd, 2025)- With energetic enthusiasm the session started with pre test assessment. Dr. Tara, Vice Chairperson & Chair of SCARF, covered the fundamentals of quantitative research, including research types and literature review.- Dr. Padmavathi R, Director of SCARF, focused on identifying research topics, formulating research questions and hypotheses, and defining research problems.- Dr.Rizwan, Scientist from ICMR, discussed choosing appropriate study designs, including experimental, observational, and non-experimental designs.

Day 2: Data Handling and Statistical Analysis (September 9th, 2025) - Ms.Jothi, Senior Biostatistician at SCARF, introduced sampling techniques, data types, and scales of measurement. The session covered data collection methods, sample size calculation, and descriptive statistics, including mean, median, mode, standard deviation, and range. Data visualization using tables, graphs, and charts was also emphasized.

Day 3: Practical Skills in Data Handling and Statistical Analysis (September 16th, 2025)- Ms.Jothi introduced software tools like Excel and SPSS for data entry and summarization. Basic statistical tests, including corre-



summarization. Basic statistical tests, including correlation and simple comparative analyses, were discussed. Dr. Suresh Kumar, Psychiatric Consultant at PSYMED, guided participants on interpreting research results and presenting data effectively. A hands-on group activity allowed participants to practice data entry and statistical analyses using SPSS.

Day 4: Research Proposal Development and Ethics (September 23rd, 2025)- The session started with an engaging talk on "Writing a Concept Note" by Dr. Lakshmi, Assistant Director, Department of Psychosocial Rehabilitation, who emphasized the importance of clarity and structure in early-stage research planning. Dr. Karthikeyan stressed the importance of preparing clear and accurate budget proposals for funded projects. He highlighted that a well-structured budget is critical not only for securing funding but also for ensuring smooth project execution and compliance with funding agency norms. Dr. Subhashini Gopal, Assistant Director at SCARF, underscored the ethical responsibilities of researchers. The program concluded with a feedback session and post-assessment.

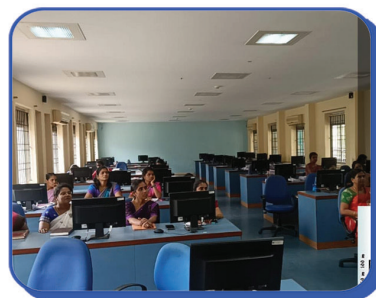
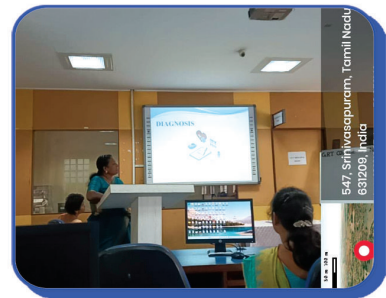
The Faculty Development Programme provided valuable insights and practical experience in research methodology and statistical analysis, enhancing the faculty's research and analytical skills.

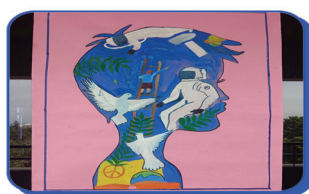




NSS ACTIVITIES

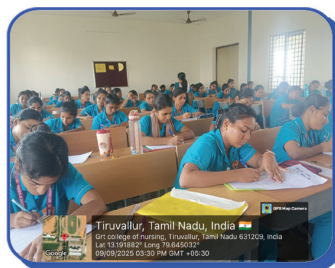
4.TOURISM DAY

NDLI CLUB ACTIVITIES 1. TIPUP PROGRAM

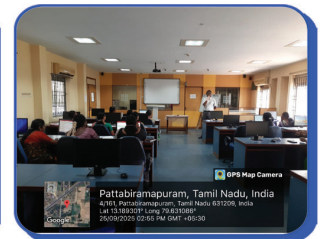
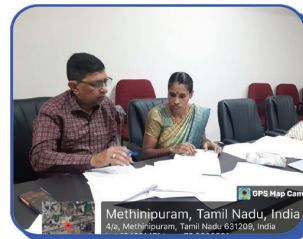

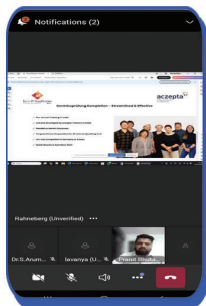
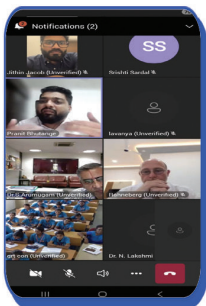
ISO 21001 1. INTERNAL AUDIT TRAINING MEETING

உங்கள் அனைத்து முயற்சிகளுக்கும் அர்ப்பணிப்புக்கும் மீண்டும் நன்றி.

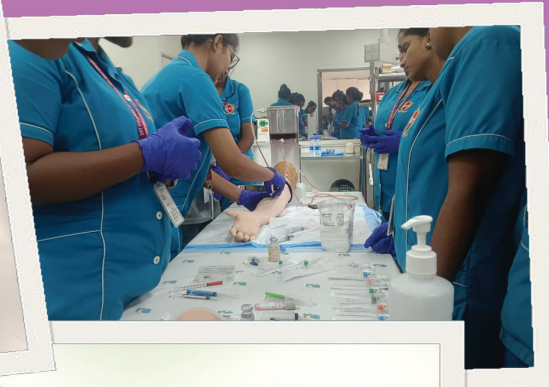
